Microsoft's free upgrade offer for Windows 10 ended last week, or did it? The software giant has introduced a "free upgrade offer extension" for Windows 7 and Windows 8.1 users who use assistive technologies. PASSWORD Vs PASSPHRASE: 5 Reasons to Use a Passphrase –

The debate between passwords versus passphrases is currently the trending buzz online. After all the password hacking and identity theft incidents have caught media attention, a lot of online users have now become aware of the ominous danger that is lurking in the world of the Internet.

Hence, the recommendation to use passphrases instead of passwords by "Information Technology," experts just came at the right time.

However, some people are still confused as to the difference between a password and a passphrase, and why the latter is more reliable.

The difference between passwords and passphrases:

A password, as you know, is typically composed of letters or symbols, or a combination of both. It could be a string of random symbols such as "B@3!&O\$\$" or a combination of both such as "sh@tup!".

A passphrase is longer than a password and contains spaces in between words such as this: "The road to success is always under construction!"

A passphrase can also contain symbols, and does not have to be a proper sentence or grammatically correct. The main difference of the two is that passwords do not have spaces while passphrases have spaces and are longer than any random string of letters/ numbers/ symbols. So why is a passphrase better than passwords?

Passphrases are easier to remember than a random password of symbols and letters combined together. It would be easier to remember a phrase from your favorite song, favorite quotation, than to remember a short but complicated password.

Passwords are relatively easy to guess or crack by both human and robots. The online criminals have developed state-of-the-art hacking tools that are designed to crack even the most complicated password.

Passphrases Satisfy complex rules easily. The use of punctuation, upper and lower cases in Passphrases also meets the complexity requirements for passwords.

Major OS and applications supports passphrases. All major OS' including Windows, Linux and Mac allow passphrases of up to 127 characters long. Hence, you can opt for longer passphrases for maximum security.

Passphrases are next to impossible to crack because most of the highly-efficient password cracking tools break down at around 10 characters. Hence, even the most advanced cracking tool won't be able to guess, brute-force or pre-compute passphrases.

I recommend you change your MO and use passphrases.

If the Password block requires 8 to 16 characters, use all 16 in a passphrase.

REAL EVIDENCE OF FORCED WINDOWS 10 UPGRADES – On May 12, Microsoft changed its policy on Win10 upgrades. The company now picks a date for your machine's migration to the new OS. Once that date is set, all users can seemingly do is wait for the upgrade to finish and then decide whether to roll back to Win7 or Win8.1.

On some Win10-upgrade prompts, Microsoft has provided an opt-out path. But the option is a link that could easily be missed if you're not looking for it. Moreover, there was no option to cancel the upgrade; the installation process started without explicit approval. Not surprisingly, Microsoft's heavy-handed push to upgrade Win7 and Win8.1 users to the newest Windows version has generated

loud and public complaints, such as articles in PC World and Paul Thurrott.

It seems clear that Microsoft considers itself the IT administrator of consumer Windows machines. 9/15/16lt's true that millions of PCs are now running Windows 10. But Microsoft doesn't seem concerned that upgrading might break critical software and hardware that will never be upgraded to support Win10. Yes, the "Get Windows 10" app is supposed to check for compatibility, but it's far from perfect — as also is the OS roll-back system.

Like good administrators, Microsoft tests updates before pushing them out. But its thinking seems to be that an update is okay if it works on most PCs. Windows 10 is a heck of an update — one in which Microsoft isn't taking responsibility for any productivity and/or peripheral loss.

If you're still on Win7 or Win8.1, I strongly recommend taking back control of the Win10-upgrade process. Windows Secrets has suggested W9/15/16in10-blocking tools such as GWX Control Panel or Never10. We prefer GWX Control Panel because it can actually check and remove the local Win10-installer folder.

If at some point you decide you do want Win10, the blockers are easily removed. I also suggest downloading the Win10 installer from the MS TechBench website. It's from Microsoft, but it has fewer issues than the Windows Update-based process.

SERIOUS SECURITY EXPLOITS FOUND IN 7-ZIP, UPDATE AVAILABLE – May 15, 2016 – Users running popular open source file archiving utility, 7-Zip, should update it immediately. Two major security flaws have been discovered in the software, which can be used to compromise personal data. 7-Zip is used by many a lot of people out there as well as third-party vendors to compress large files in applications.

7-Zip is supported on all major platforms, and is one of the most popular archive utilities in-use today.

Fortunately, the exploit has been fixed in the latest version of 7-Zip software, which at the time of this writing is version 16.0. To find out the version of you have installed launch the 7-Zip File Manager, and go to Help > About 7-Zip.

MALWAREBYTES COMING OUT WITH ANTI-RANSOMWARE SOFTWARE – If you don't know what ransomware is, then hopefully you will never find out. What it does is infect your computer and encrypt all of your files essentially holding them hostage so you don't have any access to them. In order to get your access back you need to pay a "ransom" to the people who encrypted your files.

These people are most likely overseas where you don't have any legal means to get your files back. Once you pay the ransom which can be hundreds of dollars or more you will then get a key to unlock your files. Then again, sometimes you pay and never get a key and are out of luck.

Malwarebytes – (who is known for its effective anti-malware software) is developing new anti-ransomware software which is now in beta testing.

Beta = Before a commercial software program is released to the public, it usually goes through a "beta" phase. During this stage, the software is tested for bugs, crashes, errors, inconsistencies, and any other problems. Beta testing can result in software problems on your PC. Use Beta software at your own risk.

Malwarebytes bought EasySync Solutions which created CryptoMonitor and hired its developer to help create their new software called <u>Malwarebytes Anti-Ransomware</u>. The software uses proactive technology that monitors what ransomware is doing and stops it before it gets to your files.

SCAMMERS TARGET SMARTPHONES THROUGH SOFTWARE UPDATES – The next time you need a software update on your cell phone, make sure it's legitimate.

In the tech support scam, crooks call or email smart phones at random and claim an attempted software update has failed because of a virus. They say the purported problem can be remedied via a \$10 credit card payment. The scammer not only collects the money but also has the credit card number that can be used later for fraudulent charges.

TrendMicro and the United State Computer Emergency Readiness Team (US-CERT) are both recommending that all Windows users immediately uninstall QuickTime thanks to critical vulnerabilities that Apple has no intention of fixing. Apple is no longer supporting QuickTime with security fixes. QuickTime for Apple's OS X operating system is still supported.

Apple confirmed to The Wall Street Journal that it is no longer supporting or updating the 11-yearold QuickTime 7 for Windows, and has posted instructions for uninstalling the software.

QuickTime is a lot like Java, in that you probably don't need to have it installed. If you do need it, however, it may prove difficult to replace, and Apple isn't currently helping matters. The company has not updated the QT webpage to inform users that the software is no longer maintained, and the Apple Software Update tool is still pushing QuickTime to end users.






