You can still get Windows 10 for free with this trick

Microsoft's free upgrade offer for Windows 10 ended last week, or did it? The software giant has introduced a "free upgrade offer extension" for Windows 7 and Windows 8.1 users who use assistive technologies. While, technically, the free upgrade offer for the general public has ended, Microsoft has introduced a loophole with this extension that lets anyone get Windows 10 for free.

"Microsoft isn't checking who is using the upgrade extension"

All you need to do is download an EXE file from Microsoft's hidden away accessibility site, and the Windows 10 upgrade will commence without any checks. Microsoft says it has not announced an end date for the upgrade extension, and the company will make a public announcement when it plans to remove the free Windows 10 upgrade for assistive technology users.

Microsoft is now planning to distribute a free Anniversary Update to Windows 10 tomorrow. The software update will include Cortana improvements, Windows Ink, Microsoft Edge extensions, and a lot more tweaks and new features. No matter what, if you think your account has been accessed without your permission, change your password immediately. If you don't have access to your account, use the Sign-in Helper to get back in.

Your account information has changed without your knowledge.

There are logins from locations you don't recognize on your recent activity page.

You aren't receiving expected emails. Your Yahoo Mail account is sending spam.

HOW TO USE SYSTEM RESTORE IN WINDOWS 7, 8, AND 10

System Restore is a Windows feature that can help fix certain types of crashes and other computer problems. Here's how it works, how to set it up, and how to use it when things go awry.

We're going to be using Windows 10 in this article, but System Restore has been around a long time—and works pretty much the same way in each version of Windows. The instructions here are good for Windows 7, 8, and 10, and you'll encounter only minor differences throughout the process.

What is System Restore?

When something goes wrong on your system as a result of a bad piece of software—maybe an app you installed, or a driver that broke something important—it can be hard to fix. System Restore lets you restore your Windows installation back to its last working state.

It does this by creating “restore points” every so often.

MICROSOFT MAKES WINDOWS 10 HARDWARE CHANGE FOR PC SECURITY – *Starting on July 28, Microsoft is making TPM 2.0 hardware-based security layer a requirement on Windows 10 smartphones, PCs and tablets.*

Microsoft is rolling out a change in minimum hardware requirements for Windows 10 PCs and mobile devices, and expects hardware makers to comply in order to make their devices more secure.

Starting Thursday, July 28, PC makers should include a hardware-based security feature called TPM (Trusted Platform Module) 2.0 in Windows 10 PCs, smartphones and tablets. The TPM 2.0 feature will be beneficial for users as it will do a better job of protecting sensitive information on a PC. A TPM 2.0 security layer—which can be in the form of a chip or firmware—can safeguard user data by managing and storing cryptographic keys in a trusted container.

MICROSOFT GIVEN 3 MONTHS TO FIX WINDOWS 10 SECURITY AND PRIVACY – France’s privacy watchdog has declared that windows 10 is gobbling up too much data and snooping on users’ browsing without their consent.

The National Data Protection Commission (CNIL) has given Microsoft 3 months to get its act together and to get compliant with the French Data Protection Act. (DY - Still waiting???)

By default, Windows requires you to prove that you’re you every time you boot or just wake the computer out of sleep mode. There are good reasons for that. FORCED WINDOWS 10 UPGRADES – On May 12, Microsoft changed its policy on Win10 upgrades. The company now picks a date for your machine’s migration to the new OS. Once that date is set, all users can seemingly do is wait for the upgrade to finish and then decide whether to roll back to Win7 or Win8.1.

On some Win10-upgrade prompts, Microsoft has provided an opt-out path. But the option is a link that could easily be missed if you’re not looking for it. Moreover, there was no option to cancel the upgrade; the installation process started without explicit approval. Not surprisingly, Microsoft’s heavy-handed push to upgrade Win7 and Win8.1 users to the newest Windows version has generated loud and public complaints, such as articles in PC World and Paul Thurrott.

It seems clear that Microsoft considers itself the IT administrator of consumer Windows machines. 10/14/16 It’s true that millions of PCs are now running Windows 10. But Microsoft doesn’t seem concerned that upgrading might break critical software and hardware that will never be upgraded to support Win10. Yes, the “Get Windows 10” app is supposed to check for compatibility, but it’s far from perfect — as also is the OS roll-back system.

Like good administrators, Microsoft tests updates before pushing them out. But its thinking seems to be that an update is okay if it works on most PCs. Windows 10 is a heck of an update — one in which Microsoft isn’t taking responsibility for any productivity and/or peripheral loss.

If you're still on Win7 or Win8.1, I strongly recommend taking back control of the Win10-upgrade process. Windows Secrets has suggested W10/14/16in10-blocking tools such as GWX Control Panel or Never10. We prefer GWX Control Panel because it can actually check and remove the local Win10-installer folder.

GWX Control Panel - Ultimate Outsider [http://ultimateoutsider.com/downloads/GWX Control Panel](http://ultimateoutsider.com/downloads/GWX%20Control%20Panel). This is a free tool that can remove and disable the 'Get Windows 10' notification area icon on Windows 7 and Windows 8.

If at some point you decide you do want Win10, the blockers are easily removed. I also suggest downloading the [from the MS TechBench website](http://www.microsoft.com/Windows/10/Upgrade/Windows10UpgradeTool.aspx). It's from Microsoft, but it has fewer issues than the Windows UWin10 installer update-based process.

Web Helpful Tips-1 used Zoom conferencing for our March SIG. We connected with Hewie Poplock from Florida for his presentation. He is a member of APCUG's Speakers Bureau.

There are several advantages to using the free Zoom Video Conferencing tool. First, it has a plug-in for all our devices, Tablets, iPads, phones, laptops, etc. You can find them at the Google Play, or the Apple App store or directly at their site, <https://www.zoom.us/download>. And it's really simple to use. The plug-in will automatically install itself the first time you try to join or share your device screen for a Zoom meeting. When I tested it in our household, my husband, Mario, at first couldn't hear me from his iPad. Then he discovered and responded to "connect to audio using Internet connection" and that fixed it. The product is very intuitive. The toolbar appears and you have instantly all you need to view the meeting and control your participation.

ZoomScheduling a meeting can be done in several ways. You can send or be sent an eMail to join a meeting, or as a host you can schedule a date and time for those to join you. The free Zoom Conference version allows up to 50 invitees for a 40 minute session. When you join a meeting it is best if you chat (type your response or questions) to avoid feedback from devices. You can mute your audio and even disengage your video for your own privacy. This way you can enjoy watching the presentation from your office or home without disrupting it.

Once the plug in is installed, for all future meetings you will only need to sign in and enter the meeting number. Most folks just copy and paste that number into the login screen. You may also see Copy Link in the e-Invite (electronic invite) link. This copies to your clip board and all you need to do is open a new Browser window and Paste and Go. I have posted a YouTube series of videos on how to install and use this tool. It is on the Club's Blog site at the Build Digital Skills tab. Here you can play these and find out how simple it is.

Hewie also gave a presentation at their April 26 general meeting. He provided a link for this presentation so they could invite home-bound members to attend on line while he presented to their group. 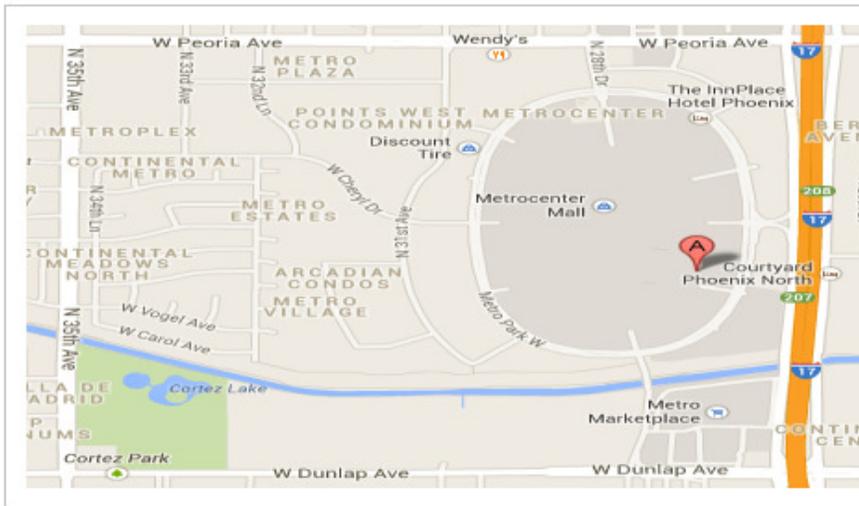

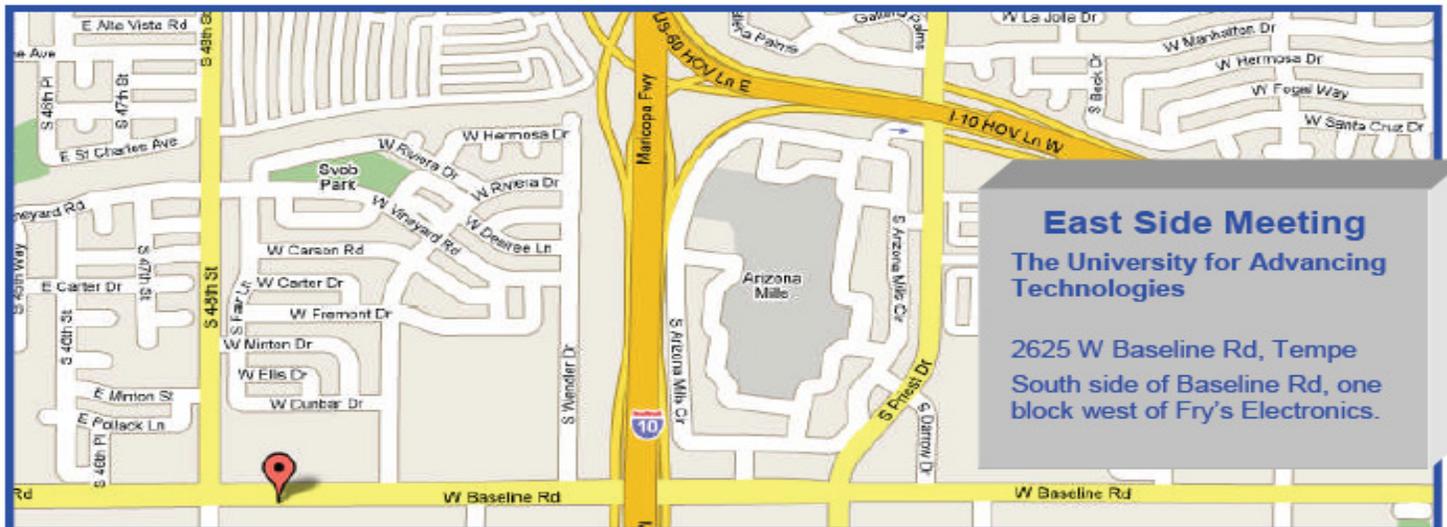

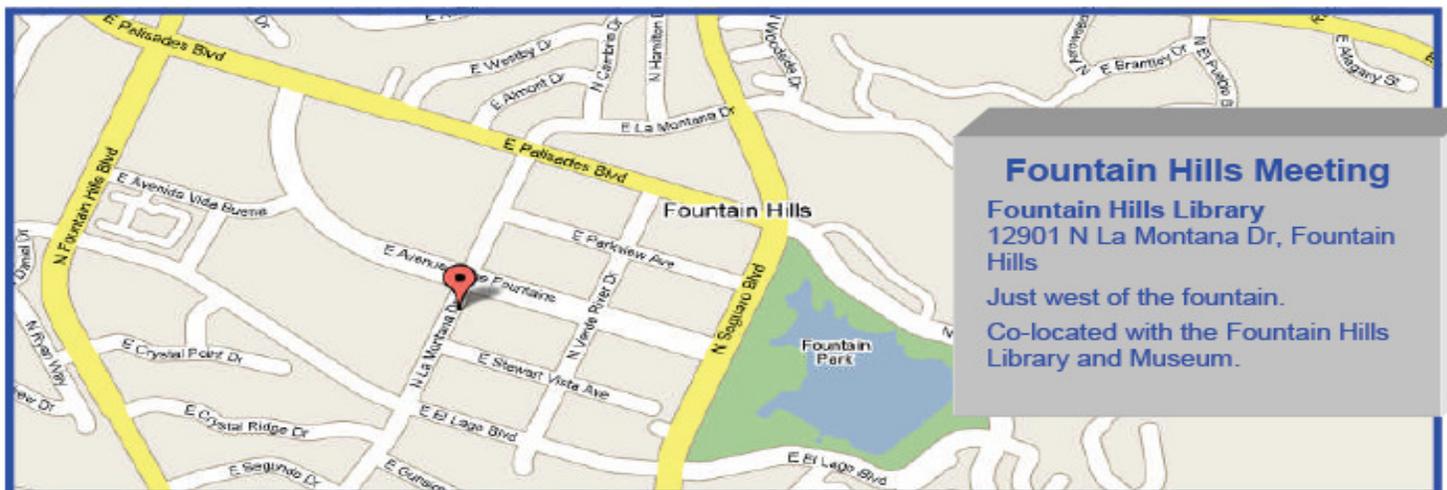
